Fairfield, California – The Superior Court of California, County of Solano is pleased to announce the creation of a new Domestic Violence Services Coordinator position, made possible through a grant from the Administrative Office of the Courts.

The Domestic Violence Services Coordinator will work in the Solano Legal Access Center, located at the Hall of Justice, 600 Union Avenue, Fairfield. Duties will include providing free direct assistance and instruction to self-represented litigants in the completion and submission of Applications for Protective Orders and Answers related to Elder Abuse, Civil Harassment, and Domestic Violence. Services will be provided in English and Spanish, utilizing various methods, such as one-on-one consultation sessions and special workshops.

Family Law Facilitator and Solano Legal Access Center Manager Richard deBlois, stated, “The Domestic Violence Services Coordinator will provide increased legal access to self-represented litigants in the area of family law.” Family Law Judge Wendy Getty, commented, “The additional services afforded by our new Domestic Violence Services Coordinator will be an invaluable service to the families of Solano County.”

In addition to those duties described above, a major responsibility of the Domestic Violence Services Coordinator will be to research and coordinate protective order cases with existing Family, Juvenile, Probate and Criminal cases to ensure that judges are aware of all cases involving the same parties and to eliminate potential for conflicting orders.
