**LAW AND MOTION** matters are heard Wednesdays and Fridays. Hearing dates are reserved by the civil calendar clerk, (707) 207-7332.

**EX PARTE HEARINGS** are heard Tuesdays through Fridays at 8:30 a.m. Call Department Eleven to obtain permission to set a hearing date. Notice to the other parties must be given in accordance with California Rules of Court, rule 3.1203, and a copy of the moving papers must be faxed/delivered to Department Eleven no later than noon on the court day before the hearing.

**CONTINUANCE REQUESTS** for civil matters must be made in writing and must be agreed to by all parties. A request to continue a trial must be made by written noticed motion.

**TELEPHONIC COURT APPEARANCES** may be made pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 3.670, unless the Court orders otherwise. Call CourtCall directly at (888) 882-6878 to schedule an appearance.

**MANDATORY SETTLEMENT CONFERENCES:** Counsel and self-represented parties are required to comply with rule 4.11 of the Local Rules.

**TENTATIVE RULINGS** for law and motion and **PREGRANTS** for probate hearings are available after 2 p.m. the court day before the scheduled hearing. You may view the tentative rulings/pregrants at the court's Web site or you may call the tentative ruling line at (707) 207-7331. Counsel and self-represented parties are required to comply with rules 3.14 through 3.17 of the Local Rules.

**COURTROOM RULES:**

- All attorneys and self-represented parties must check in with the bailiff upon arrival.
- All witnesses, jurors, and prospective jurors should wait in the hall until called to the courtroom by the bailiff.
- Cell phones and pagers must be silenced.
- No shorts, tank tops, bare feet, or other unsuitable attire.
