**SECOND AMENDED STANDING  
ORDER REGARDING PROBATE AND  
LPS MATTERS  
(EFFECTIVE MAY 18, 2020)**

**THE COURT FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Effective April 3, 2020, letters establishing special powers of administration in probate or estate matters which expire during the period of emergency operations were extended 60 days from their current date of expiration.
2. Effective May 1, 2020, letters establishing temporary probate conservatorships of a person and/or estate were extended to May 28, 2020.
3. Effective May 1, 2020, LPS conservatorships were extended until May 28, 2020, unless otherwise specifically ordered.
4. As of May 10, 2020, the court commenced processing initial petitions for letters of administration and petitions to establish fact/time/place of birth/marriage/death in probate matters.

1 5. Effective May 1, 2020, LPS conservatorships are reassigned from the Family Law  
2 Division to the Civil Division and will be heard by the Honorable Christine Carringer,  
3 Department 12.


4 6. Effective May 15, 2020, probate conservatorships are reassigned from the Family Law  
5 Division to the Civil Division and will be heard by the Honorable Alesia Jones, Department 22.

6 7. All LPS, probate and probate conservatorship matters will remain as calendared absent  
7 further case-specific written notice. While the physical courtrooms will be open, members of  
8 the public will be subject to social-distancing requirements. Attorneys, parties and interested  
9 persons attending probate or LPS proceedings are strongly encouraged to appear remotely via  
10 Zoom and/or the Zoom telephone conference line or CourtCall for all hearings. Based upon  
11 resources, some proceedings may only proceed utilizing Zoom and/or the Zoom telephone  
12 conference line. Court trials may or may not be conducted via Zoom in the discretion of the  
13 judicial officer and based upon the nature of the case or trial and court resources.

14 8. For information on how remote court is administered and requirements of participants,  
15 please refer to the Standing Order regarding Remote Proceedings for additional information.
