Dear Judge Ellis:

The following is the City of Vacaville's response to the Grand Jury Report regarding Wastewater Treatment Plants.

<u>Finding 1</u>: In many cases, wastewater effluent is not used to supply industrial needs or to irrigate crops and public lands.

Response to Finding 1: The City of Vacaville agrees with the finding.

<u>Recommendation 1</u>: Wastewater treatment facilities decision-makers consider, on an ongoing basis, if additional treated water can be used to replace current water supplies.

Response to Recommendation 1: The City of Vacaville is preparing a Recycled Water Master Plan to identify projects for recycled water use. The Plan is expected to be completed in early 2020.

Finding 3: Not all wastewater treatment plants utilize renewable sources of electrical power.

Response to Finding 3: The City of Vacaville agrees with the finding.

Recommendation 3: Consider solar and wind power as alternative energy sources.

Response to Recommendation 3: The City of Vacaville's 2019/2020 Capital Improvement Budget includes a 1-MW solar project at the Easterly Wastewater Treatment Plant.
