### ABOUT THE CARE ACT/ CARE COURT

The CARE Act connects a person in crisis with a court-ordered CARE Plan for up to 12 months, with the possibility to extend for an additional 12 months. Individuals in CARE Court will receive clinically appropriate, community-based services and supports that are culturally and linguistically competent.


