**IMPLEMENTATION ORDER OF DECEMBER 9, 2020  
GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115(a)(10)  
EMERGENCY ORDER BY CHIEF JUSTICE TANI G. CANTIL-SAKAUYE**

Exercising the authority by the Chief Justice in her local Emergency Order issued  
December 9, 2020, this Court hereby orders:

1. All Judges and Commissioners of the Solano County Superior Court are authorized to extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days, applicable only to cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from December 10, 2020 to January 31, 2021, inclusive (Gov. Code section 68115(a)(10)).
2. No trial may be extended beyond the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code pursuant to this local order, without first notifying the affected parties and providing an opportunity to object and be heard on the record.



Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, leading to health and safety concerns resulting in substantial operational impediments, and the proclamations of states of emergency by federal, state, and local officials, it was determined on March 17, April 3, and April 29, 2020, that the conditions described in Government Code section 68115 were met with regard to the Superior Court of California, County of Solano (Court). Based on those determinations, and pursuant to the Court's requests, three prior emergency orders issued, authorizing the Court to implement certain relief under Government Code section 68115. Upon the renewed request of Presiding Judge Donna L. Stashyn, it is determined that the conditions described in Government Code section 68115(a) continue to exist (Gov. Code, § 68115(c)), and it is ordered that the Court is authorized to do the following:

- Extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code (section 1382) for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days, applicable only to cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from December 10, 2020, to January 31, 2021, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).
