Effective June 18, 2021, *fully vaccinated individuals* will no longer be required to wear masks in the Solano County courthouses. As defined under CalOSHA's June 17, 2021 Order, implemented by Governor Newsom's Executive Order No. N-09-21 dated June 17, 2021, "fully vaccinated" means the person has received, at least 14 days prior, either the second dose in a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine series or a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine. Vaccines must be FDA approved; have an emergency use authorization from the FDA; or, for persons fully vaccinated outside the United States, be listed for emergency use by the World Health Organization (WHO). This order supersedes conflicting portions of Miscellaneous Order No. M-15-2020, both as originally issued as well as later amended on December 16, 2020.

Unvaccinated individuals must still wear masks in accordance with Miscellaneous Order No. M-15-2020, as amended December 16, 2020. Judicial officers may still order individuals to briefly remove or lower masks to facilitate fair and effective courtroom proceedings on a case-by-case basis.

Regardless of vaccination status, any individual may wear a mask.

This order is issued in accordance with the most recent guidelines issued by both the CDC and CDPH.
