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ELECTRONIC FILING NOW AVAILABLE FOR PROBATE LETTERS/BONDS

Fairfield, California – On April 1st, 2025, electronic filing is now available to attorneys and self-represented litigants in the Probate Division for Probate Letters/Bonds in decedent, guardianship, and conservatorship matters, including:

- Letters of Special Administration
- Letters of Administration/Testamentary
- Letters of Conservatorship (Temporary and General)
- Letters of Guardianship (Temporary and General)
- Bonds

Effective July 1, 2025, and pursuant to Local Rule 20, represented parties are required to electronically file Probate Letters/Bonds in decedent, guardianship, and conservatorship matters. Self-represented parties who do not opt to electronically file may continue to have Letters/Bonds processed in person at the Clerk's Office or via mail.
