Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order N-5-22 and the "Guidance for the Use of Face Masks" issued by the California Department of Public Health ("CDPH") on February 28, 2022, the Court adopts the following order concerning the wearing of face coverings for the Superior Court of Solano County:

- 1. This policy applies to the general public, jurors and court staff.
- CDPH and the Court strongly recommend, but do not require, that all persons
 continue to mask while in indoor public settings, including in all courthouse locations. This
 policy applies equally to vaccinated and unvaccinated persons.
- 3. The Court continues to make masks available at all security entrance stations, in jury services and all courtrooms for any individual who does not have a mask. CDPH recommends that a N95 or a KN95 mask be worn properly over the face and mouth for optimal protection.
- Pursuant to the Cal OSHA Emergency Temporary Standards, face coverings are required during workplace outbreaks and while utilizing employer-provided transportation.

- The Court may revisit the wearing of masks in the event of a workplace outbreak, a local surge in COVID-19 cases or in the event of other orders by health authorities.
- 6. Persons who choose to wear a mask will be allowed to do so, unless court operational or judicial needs require otherwise. A judicial officer may require an individual who chooses to wear a mask to remove a mask as needed to facilitate fair and effective courtroom proceedings.
- 7. An individual judicial officer may establish rules regarding the use of masks in his or her courtroom based upon specific department or judicial needs as appropriate.
- 8. This order shall take effect March 14, 2022 and remain in effect until this Court rescinds this order.
