Dear Judge Ellis:

This letter is in response to the report issued by the 2017-2018 Solano County Grand Jury on law enforcement agencies' Code Enforcement process. The Fairfield Police Department proffers the following information regarding the findings of the 2017-2018 Grand Jury.

Finding 1 – The City of Fairfield agrees with this finding.

Recommendation 1 – The City of Fairfield agrees with the recommendation and will continue to seek voluntary compliance while instituting fines as a last resort.

Finding 2 – The Fairfield Police Department agrees with this finding.

Recommendation 2 – The Fairfield Police Department agrees with this recommendation and has established community outreach efforts, increased public education, and increased proactive Code Enforcement efforts. Sixty-nine percent of Fairfield Police Department Code Enforcement Unit activities in March 2018, seventy percent of April 2018 activities, and sixty-six percent of May 2018 activities were generated proactively. The Fairfield Police Department agrees ongoing active efforts, community outreach, education, and collaboration with business partners is essential.

Finding 4 – The Fairfield Police Department agrees with this finding.


