Dear Judge Nelson,

In accordance with Section 933 of the California Penal Code, the City of Vallejo provides the following responses in respect to Findings #2, #3 and #4 and Recommendations #2, #3 and #4 identified in the 2013-2014 Grand Jury Report entitled "Geographic Information System (GIS)".

1. *Grand Jury Finding #2: Some upper levels of public agency management are not actively supporting and participating in the implementation of ReGIS.*

City Response: The City agrees with the finding.

2. *Grand Jury Recommendation #2: Upper levels of public agency management actively support and participate in the implementation of ReGIS.*

City Response: The recommendation has been implemented. The Chief Information Officer of the City of Vallejo has been in contact with the project lead from Solano County and the City of Vallejo is actively supporting the implementation of ReGIS.

3. *Grand Jury Finding #3: Management attendance at ReGIS meetings has been poor.*

City Response: The City agrees with the finding.

4. *Grand Jury Recommendation #3: Management attend and encourage attendance by representatives from their agency at ReGIS meetings.*

City Response: The recommendation has not yet been implemented, but beginning September 18th at the next ReGIS monthly meeting, the Chief Information Officer of the City of Vallejo and/or additional management designees will attend scheduled meetings.

5. *Grand Jury Finding #4: Representation of agencies at ReGIS meetings has been mostly by non-management employees who have limited or no commitment authority.*

City Response: The City agrees with the finding.

6. *Grand Jury Recommendation #4: In the absence of management attendance, management appoint and authorize an employee to commit and support ReGIS activities.*

City Response: The recommendation has not yet been implemented, but beginning September 18th at the next ReGIS monthly meeting, the City of Vallejo will provide sufficient management authority to their representative(s) during all meetings that require it.
