On behalf of the City Council of the City of Dixon and with its prior approval, I hereby submit to you the responses of the City Council to the findings and recommendations contained in the above noted report dated April 26, 2010, as set forth below:

**Investigation: Detention/Holding Facilities**

"California Penal Code 919, subsection (b) provides: "The Grand Jury shall inquire into the condition and management of the public prisons within the County." Pursuant to the statute, the 2009-2010 Grand Jury inspected the Dixon Police Department Holding Facility located at 201 West A Street, Dixon, California.

**Findings and Recommendations:**

There were no Findings or Recommendations in the report. The report was very positive in nature. Under "Comments" the report indicated: "The DPD staff was very cooperative. The Department works with the community and the schools to educate people on the role of the police department. The City of Dixon has shown innovation by utilizing the economy of scale in combination with the Solano County Sheriff's Office by leasing its vehicles through the Sheriff's Office and by contracting for dispatching services."
