**SOLANO COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT INTRODUCES
ELECTRONIC FILING (E-FILING)**

Fairfield, California – The Superior Court of California, County of Solano is pleased to announce the launch of its electronic filing system, scheduled to commence on Monday, February 5, 2024. Initially, e-filing will be available for attorneys and self-represented litigants in civil, small claims, family, and probate case types.

To facilitate electronic filing, Solano Court has established an Electronic Filing Service Providers (EFSP) list, which can be accessed on the court's website at www.solano.courts.ca.gov. The website contains detailed information on how to create a new e-filing account, a quick e-filing guide, and a comprehensive FAQ section to address common questions.

The implementation of this e-filing system has been an extensive process, with months of preparation, including integration and mapping of data from our current case management system eCourt.

Following the successful deployment, Solano Court will continue its efforts to enhance the system by integrating with our justice partners for e-filing in criminal and juvenile case types. Dates for the go-live of each stage will be announced in the future, demonstrating our commitment to modernizing the court system and improving access to justice for all.

With implementation of any new system, there will be a learning curve for users and issues to problem solve. However, because e-filing is already used in so many California courts, we do not expect significant issues.
